- School based Mentors e.g. IAMs and EGA (Ayse Ahmet) teams. (Funded by EiC and standards fund – Same fund for LSUs)
- IAMs, CFS, IGS have specialist LMS who focus on Ethnic minority achievement (posts are EiC funded).
- Role Models (Sara McLaughlin - EMAS)
- EiC primary learning mentors (Sandy Posnikoff)
- EiC secondary learning mentors (was Pravahi Osman)
- Connexions Turkish worker (Hackney - but will take on Islington cases- issues/careers orientated)
- Connexions service PAs (**at Central Foundation is issues orientated**).
- Senior Learning Mentor (Advisory – Cassius Francis)
- Teaching staff acting as Learning Mentors in schools (Secondary- academic focus- school managed)
- Chance Mentors (Finsbury Park)
- 100 Black Men (Nationwide)
- Refugee (Mobile pupils) Learning Mentor (EiC Maggie Ryan – Sandy Posnikoff's team)
- Peer mentoring.
- Business sector mentors (Bob Robinson- mainly G&T)
- Academic mentoring for Literacy in Year 8 from standards fund – direct to school.
- Derman (Turkish/Kurdish project)- Hackney. Can work with pupils from Hackney in Islington schools.
- 'East London Schools Partnership' Schools buy in mentors from them. They train, employ and manage.
- 'Africa Youth Trust' Comfort Arthur.
- Community Service Volunteer (Primary at moment)- Sandy Posnikoff.
- 'Excellence Challenge' has some money that can be used for mentoring @14 to 19years
- Ethnic Minority mentors from EiC e.g. Islington Green A/C boys project.
